## PIECES OF A BOX.


1.- LONG SIDE
2.- END SIDE
3.- BOTTOM

Furthermore, a box can have a lid.
You must be careful: in this case the end side is fitted between the two long sides.


However, it could be the opposite.

| Noun | Adjetive |
| :--- | :---: |
| Height | High |
| Width | Wide |
| Depth | Deep |
| Length | Long |
| Thickness | Thick |

WATCH OUT: we often use these words incorrectly in Spanish. We usually change a noun for its adjective.

## Asking About the Size.

- How big is it?
- What are their exact measurements?.
- How high is it? The wall is 2 meters high.
-How wide is it? It's 2 millimeters wide.
-How deep are they? They're 30 centimeters deep.
-How long is it? The long side is 30 centimeters long.
-How thick are they? They're 24 millimeters thick.
- We're at a height of 235 meters above sea level.
- What's the width of this table?
-It's the wrong length.
-I need screws of a different thickness.
