

WATCH OUT: we often use these words incorrectly in Spanish. We usually change a noun for its adjective.

Asking About the Size.

- How **big** is it?
- What are their exact measurements?.
- How high is it? The wall is 2 meters high.
- •How wide is it? It's 2 millimeters wide.
- •How deep are they? They're 30 centimeters deep.
- •How **long** is it? The long side is 30 centimeters **long**.
- •How thick are they? They're 24 millimeters thick.
- We're at a height of 235 meters above sea level.
- What's the **width** of this table?
- •It's the wrong <u>length</u>.
- •I need screws of a different thickness.
