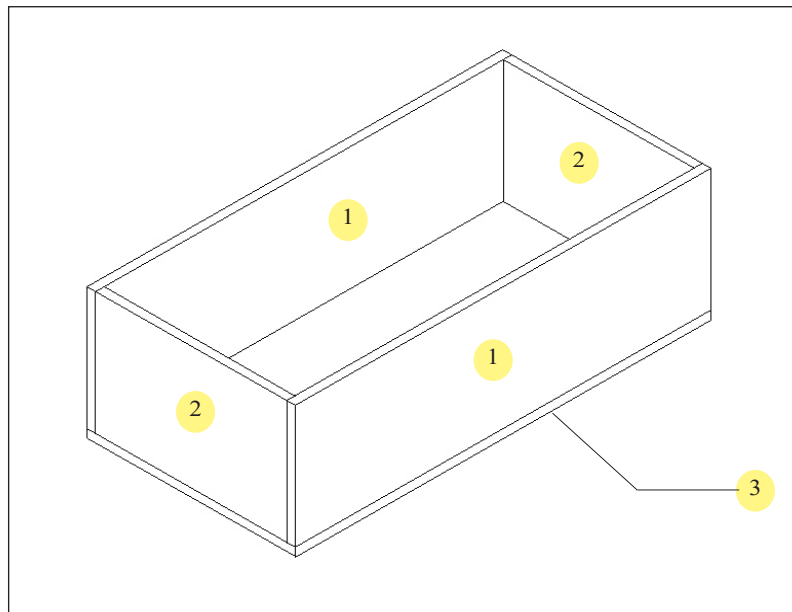


TAKING TO PIECES.

PIECES OF A BOX.



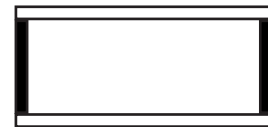
1.- LONG SIDE

2.- END SIDE

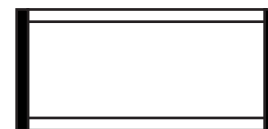
3.- BOTTOM

Furthermore, a box can have a lid.

You must be careful: in this case **the end side is fitted between the two long sides.**



However, it could be the opposite.



GRAMMAR AND VOCABULARY: HOW TO BUILD A BOX?. BUILDING A BOX.

Noun	Adjective
Height	High
Width	Wide
Depth	Deep
Length	Long
Thickness	Thick

WATCH OUT: we often use these words incorrectly in Spanish. We usually change a noun for its adjective.

Asking About the Size.

- How **big** is it?
- What are their exact measurements?.
- How **high** is it? The wall is 2 meters **high**.
- How **wide** is it? It's 2 millimeters **wide**.
- How **deep** are they? They're 30 centimeters **deep**.
- How **long** is it? The long side is 30 centimeters **long**.
- How **thick** are they? They're 24 millimeters **thick**.
- We're at a height of 235 meters above sea level.
- What's the **width** of this table?
- It's the wrong **length**.
- I need screws of a different **thickness**.
